

Getting Started with Skill Struck

FOR GRADES K-12

1. Sign In



- Visit: www.skillstruck.com.
- Select the "Log In" button on the top right corner.
- Use your respective integration to access your Educator Portal. (i.e. Google, Microsoft, Clever, ClassLink)

NOTE

If you have trouble logging in, email support@skillstruck.com letting them know your district and school site.

2. Manage Your Sections



+ **Sections:** Sections are like classes. Students are rostered into sections, and you can assign curriculum to them.

+ Navigation:

- From the Educator Portal, go to "Manage Sections."
 - Sections should auto-populate from your respective integration. If you do not have a rostering integration, then you must [create new sections](#) and [add students](#) to each section.

+ Basic Settings for Sections:

- Go to "Manage Sections" and click the pencil icon next to the section name.
- Options:
 - Rename the section.
 - **MUST DO: Set platform to Launch Pad (K-5) or Voyage (6-12).** *The platform you set here, is the platform students will gain access to.*
 - Browse other setting options and toggle on those you'd like to activate.

3. Assign Curriculum



+ Setup:

- From the Educator Portal, go to "[Manage Curriculum](#)."
- Filter content by toggling to "Launchpad (K-5)" or "Voyage (6-12)" on the top, or by grade level on the left.
- Click the blue "Assign" button on the course you want to assign.
- Follow the instructions to select a section, **assign units/lessons**, and manage your required activities.
- "Apply to additional sections" if needed, or click "Save" to assign.

4. Explore Lesson Plans



+ Lesson Plans: Lesson Plans can be found in 2 places:

1. On the Educator Portal under "Resources"
2. On the Manage Curriculum page within each course card where it says "Course details & lesson plans"

NOTE

Lessons requiring use of the platform/online component are marked with a teal "Platform Lesson" label. Lessons without the "Platform Lesson" label are "Un-Plugged," meaning they will not require the online platform.

5. Monitor Student Progress



+ Progress Check:

- From the Educator Portal, navigate to "[Student Progress](#)."
- Select the section, then "unit" or "lesson" to view progress.
- Details: Click on progress circles for detailed student activity. If you are viewing a specific lesson, you can sort by checkpoint, quiz, challenges, or games.
